In addition to Facts On File's extensive print literature reference collection, *Bloom's Literary Reference Online* features the writings of renowned academic Harold Bloom, as well as many other critics. Hundreds of Professor Bloom's essays are included, examining the lives and works of great writers throughout history and the world, as well as thousands of critical articles published by noted scholars under the Bloom's Literary Criticism imprint.

Unlike many resources, this database also contains an archive of more than 42,000 characters, as well as extensive entries on literary topics, themes, movements, and genres. The invaluable new dictionary tool allows users to look up more than 34,000 words without needing to open a new browser window or go outside the database, and the addition of almost 170 video segments enables students to study literature through an engaging visual medium. "How to Cite" guidance has also been added.

Features:

- **Authors:** biographies of thousands of authors from around the world, browsable by nationality, type of writing, or time periods ranging from ancient to modern
- **Works:** overviews, synopses, analyses, and literary criticism of thousands of works—from novels to poetry to plays—browsable by genre and time period or alphabetically
- **Videos:** video segments covering a range of topics—from biographies of writers to critical analysis of plays to literary genres
- **Topics and Themes:** in-depth, full-text entries on literary movements, literary groups, magazines and newspapers, and historical events that help place literature in context, as well as definitions of literary terms
- **Timeline:** more than 15,000 entries on births, deaths, publications, and events in world literature from the ancient era to the present day
- **Dictionary:** more than 34,000 entries with concise, informative definitions, many with pronunciation, etymology, and syllable breaks of the word



- **Characters:** information on more than 42,000 major and minor literary characters, including where they first appeared, what part they played in the plot, and how they are related to other literary characters
- **Harold Bloom's Western Canon:** Professor Bloom's selections of the major works of Western literature through the present day.

Easy-to-use Browse and Search Functions

Handy browse and search features lead readers quickly and easily through the database, providing in-text links, persistent record links, and numerous options for further research. Search results are organized within tabs, by record type, garnering highly relevant results. It's easy to click on the tabs to move between different types of resources on the search results page, and users can also scroll to the next or previous entry in the search results list from within each entry.

In addition to searching, users can also browse each content category for more specific results—by time period within American, British, and world literature; by author type, including Novelists, Poets, and Short Story Writers; by literary genre, including Drama, Essays and Speeches, and Science Fiction; by nationality for all authors; by an A-to-Z list; and by subject for all videos. Author biographies link users to a list of major works, and works are linked to a list of principal characters.
